Ključ - Bosnia-Herzegovina



"All inclusive – Applying Artistic Theatre Methods in Youth Work with Handicapped or Disadvantaged Youth" is a youth exchange inside the Erasmus+ programme of the European Union. The project intends to deliver a model for future school-focussed activities of our partners. Participating teamers of the youth exchange will learn to design own workshops. They will learn to implement their knowledge as facilitators under the guidance of experienced theatre trainers and put a theatre play on stage with an international youth group that is consisting of impaired and non-impaired youth. Participating youth will learn body oriented and artistic theatre methods, while also finding new ways of expressing themselves, becoming more self-confident and comfortable in their bodies. Main objective is for the participating youth to discover a new level of cooperation and mutual understanding of disadvantaged and non-impaired youth and new forms of communication in a joint activity. The project approaches also the inclusion of non-foreign-language speakers. Participants will organise and perform their own play based on the novel "Animal Farm" of George Orwell using self-designed materials and multi-lingual approaches. Participating organisations on the other side are planning to promote this model of theatre techniques to implement further projects of theatre plays in cooperation with other institutions in their countries.







The venue - Ključ, Bosnia-Herzegovina

Ključ is a small town and municipality by the same name in western Bosnia and Herzegovina. It is located in the bosniak-croatian Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, specifically the Una-Sana Canton. The name of the municipality translates to "key", which remembered his military and economic position in medieval times. Ključ is located south from Sanski Most and Banja Luka in the north. How to reach Ključ

By Plane:

If you come by plane you'll probably arrive in Zagreb or Sarajevo, but the best to come is over Zagreb. In both cases you have to use a bus to Ključ (approximately 40 € there and back).

Via Zagreb:

You can use the shuttle bus from the airport to the Central Bus station (Autobusni kolodvor Zagreb) in Zagreb (one-way approx. 30 Kuna = 4.15 €) The Airport bus runs from the airport to the bus station from 5.30 to 19.30 every 30 min. Please check: http://www.plesoprijevoz.hr/schedulezg.htm In the Main Bus Station you can buy the ticket to Ključ. Please be aware, there are only 2 direct buses a day from Zagreb to Ključ (travel duration 4-5h), the first bus is leaving Zagreb at 8 a.m. (in the morning), and the second bus from Zagreb to Ključ is leaving Zagreb at 4 p.m. (in the afternoon)! The ticket is about 20.00 € Please check http://www.akz.hr/vr/voznired.aspx

The second possibility is to take first the bus to Banja Luka, then by bus to Ključ or – in case there are no buses - to be picked up by us from Banja Luka. The buses from Zagreb to Banja Luka are going at 6.30 / 9.30 / 10.30 / 13:30 / 16:30. The ticket is about $15.50 \in$ In case you choose this possibility, please inform us in advance so we can arrange the pickup service for you if necessary.

You can also use the tram (catch the tram 2,6) to go from the Main Railway Station to the Central Bus station (Autobusni kolodvor Zagreb). You can buy the tickets on the kiosks. The tickets are valid 90 minutes (one way 8.00 Kuna = 1.15 €). The tickets to Ključ you can buy in the Main Bus Station.

Via Sarajevo:

You have to use the bus (no taxi!) from the airport to the Central Bus station (Autobuska Stanica) in Sarajevo. Please take care, that there are two Bus stations in Sarajevo. Do NOT use the Station of Lukavica, ONLY serving the Republika Srpska and destinations in Serbia and Montenegro. Please go by bus to the Main Bus Station (Autobuska stanica, street: Put Zivota 8). Take bus 36 to Nedžarići (price 1.80 KM) the bus stop is located on the main road outside the airport parking lot. At Nedžarići you can change for a tram to the city centre (again 1.80 KM). Bus 36 runs about every 30 minutes. Service hours are 6-23 Monday-Friday, 6-8 and 14-18, sat and 8-15 sun. From the main bus station you go to Ključ.

In case those documents are missing, there will be no travel cost reimbursement! In case that you do not participate in the online review of the EACEA, we will be forced to recover the whole costs of the ERASMUS+ training course from you!

Currency

The domestic currency is the KM (Konvertibilna Marka), it is divided into 100 feninga. The marka has a fixed exchange rate to Euro (rate 1€= 1.95583 convertible mark). There exist ATMs of several banks. In the post office, you can change any foreign currency.
