8 persons per country - 6 participants (3 boys + 3 girls), 1 group leader and1 sign language interpreter

Participant countries - Bulgaria, Poland, Lithuania, Romania, Serbia, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina

LOCATION

Sinemorets is a village and seaside resort on the Black Sea coast of Bulgaria, located in the very southeast of the country close to the border with Turkey, where the river Veleka flows into the sea. Sinemorets is part of Tsarevo Municipality, Burgas Province, and has a population of 410 as of September 2016. It is situated in Strandzha Nature Park.

Veleka Beach is one of the most beautiful places on the Bulgarian sea coast. The place is a part of a Strandzha protected area, with clean river and sea waters, surrounded by wild forests, nice rocks and heartbreaking sunsets.

WHAT TO BRING

This is short list of items that we strongly recommend ©. Together with your usual clothes, please bring with you:

- 1. Good walking or trekking or running shoes.
- 2. Wind and waterproof jacket: the temperature during day time depending on weather conditions could be between 10 $^{\circ}$ to 30 $^{\circ}$
- 3. Rucksack: 30–40 litters capacity, must be big enough to carry the extra items
- 4. Thermal top and leggings
- 5. Warm hat
- 6. Indoor shoes (sneakers)
- 7. Sunglasses; sun-hat, high protection sun-screen
- 8. Swimming suit, towel for the beach and swimming goggles
- 9. Personal medicine
- 10. Food, drinks from your own country for the intercultural evening

WHAT TO PREPARE

- 1. To share with us your local community services for impaired people provided in the country you are from by municipality, governmental authorities and NGO (projects, services, etc...) All activities will be outdoor, so do not make digital presentation. You could bring some materials, just to tell, to prepare a game or some other kind of interesting way for presentation.
- International culture night (dinner) where you will present your food, drinks and some aspect of your culture.
 We would appreciate you bring with you some traditional food, drinks and other characteristics things from your place.

CURRENCY

Please be aware that Bulgaria does not have Euro as a currency. Change rate: 1 Euro -1.95 leva aprox. (please pay attention where you change your money - some of these services have commissions or bad rates)

TRAVEL COSTS

The program covers cost based on the travel distance per participant. Travel distances must be calculated using the distance calculator supported by the European Commission
